Introduction:

I heard a man say, "If you win a million dollars, the first thing you need to do is become a millionaire!" His point was simple: most people do not know how to handle money. In our passage today, James is going to address a group of people who used their money in evil and sinful ways. It wasn't that they did not know better. They just left God out when it came to their wealth.
